ESA Externally Set Assignment</p> <p>This is set by the exam board Eduqas</p> <p>This is a 12 self-lead project.</p> <p>Students will be marked for the GCSE out of 200 in total.</p>	<p>Component 1: Project 2. Students will begin a substantial project, independently lead which will culminate in a final piece for Mock 1.</p> <p>They will present research, responses and independent analysis and experimentation of imagery and ideas.</p> <p>Workshops and visits will take place to inspire and support coursework. Mock 1.</p>	<p>Component 2. Externally Set Assessment (Eduqas)</p> <p>Students will embark on a personal project taken from the exam paper.
