Dear Parents/Carers

You will already be aware, following yesterday's text message, that face coverings have become recommended once again. I wanted to take a moment to give further details on this.

With immediate effect, students, staff and visitors, who are not exempt, MUST wear face coverings in communal areas around the school. This means all corridors, the dining room, library, etc. Face coverings MUST also be worn while queuing for refreshments both inside and outside at the hut.

While face coverings are not currently being recommended in classrooms, those choosing to wear them in classrooms remain safest. As a result I encourage the wearing of face coverings in classrooms also.

We are keeping a close eye on what is, once again, a rapidly changing environment. If we have to make further alterations to our control measures or plans for events in the coming days, I will of course inform you immediately.

We continue to encourage testing at home, on Sundays and Wednesdays. Thank you to those who have consistently supported the safety of our community by doing this. If you have lapsed in your regular testing, I strongly encourage you to restart this immediately.
