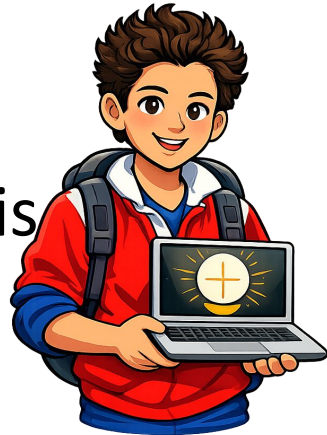

Carlo Acutis was born: May 3, 1991. He died: October 12, 2006, in Monza, Italy (aged 15).

Known for his passion for the Eucharist and his skill in computer programming.

He was a keen gamer and coder and used his talents to create a website documenting Eucharistic Miracles.

Acutis is remembered as a model for young Catholics, showing how faith and modern technology can coexist. His life emphasizes kindness, service, and love for God even in ordinary daily life.

She was passionate about education and helping the poor.

She was drawn to the Catholic faith after the death of her husband.

She was a dedicated teacher and founded the Sisters of Charity to help run schools and care for those in need.
