L. Has risen, as he said, alleluia.

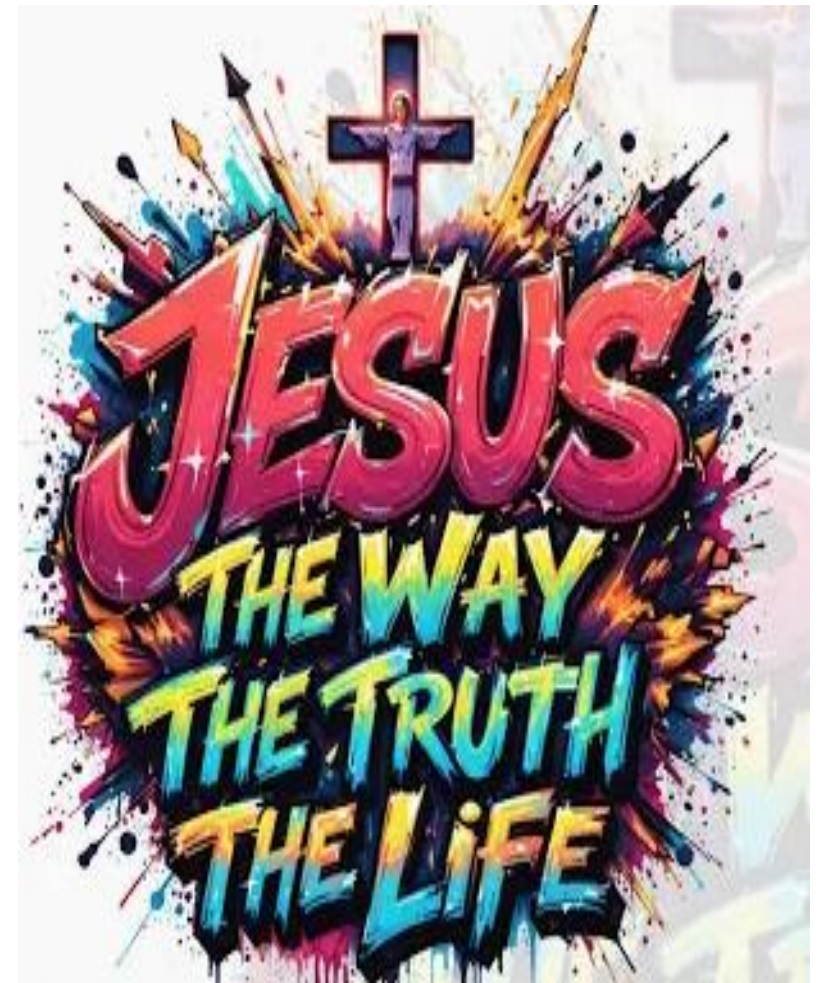
R. Pray for us to God, alleluia.

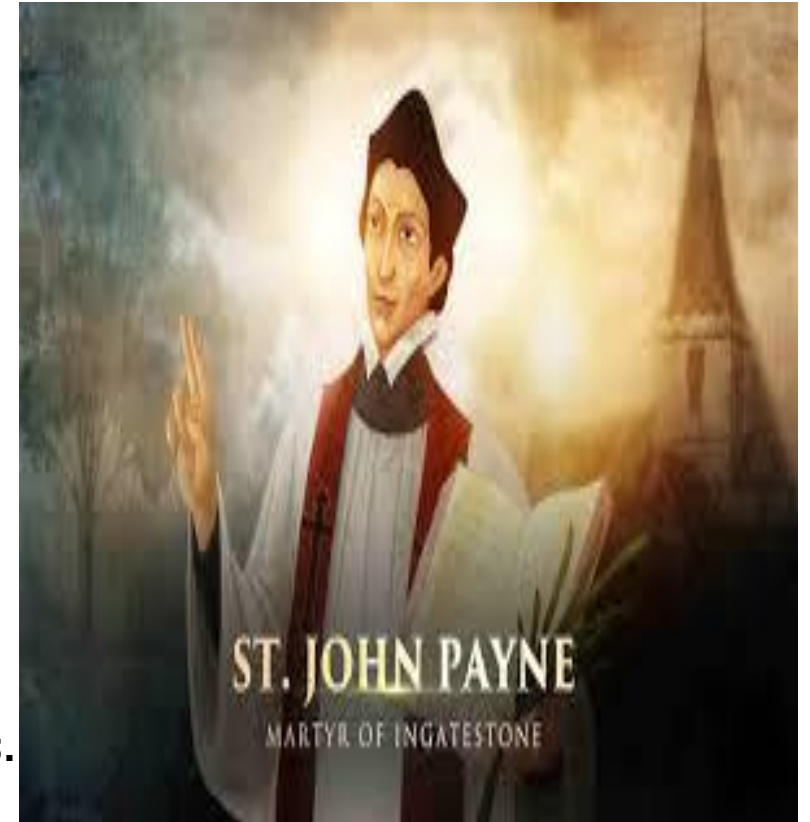

lives.

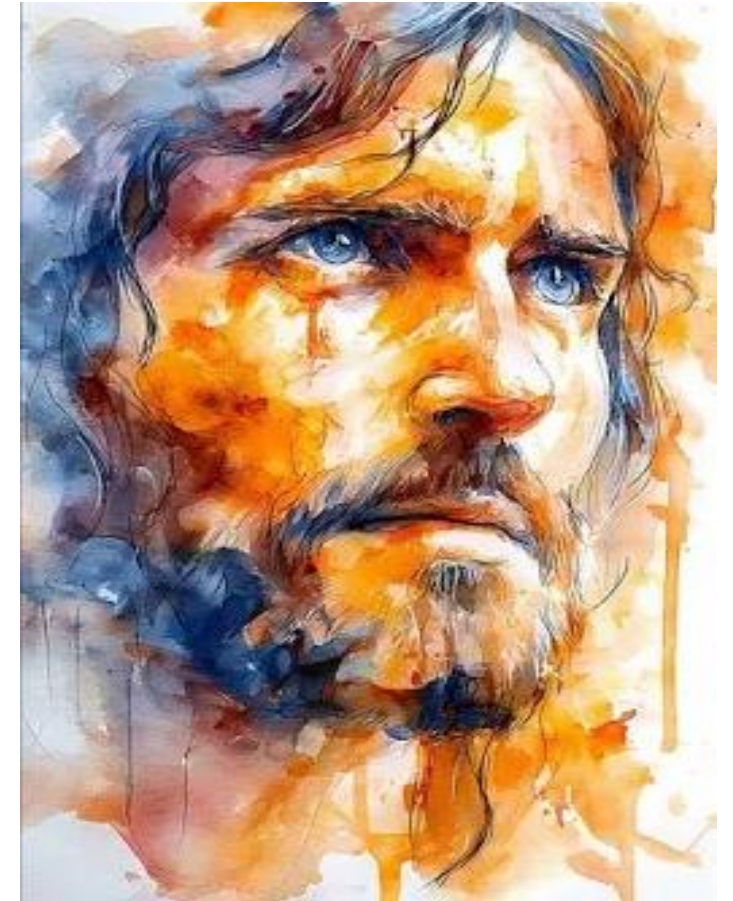
Guide them to choose the path you have

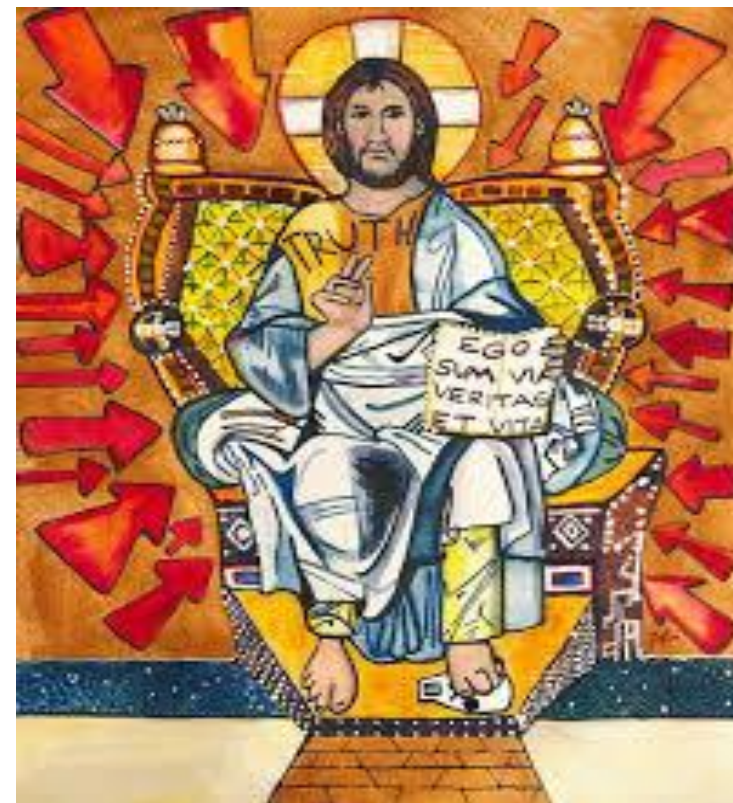
2. When we pray, we should use the
