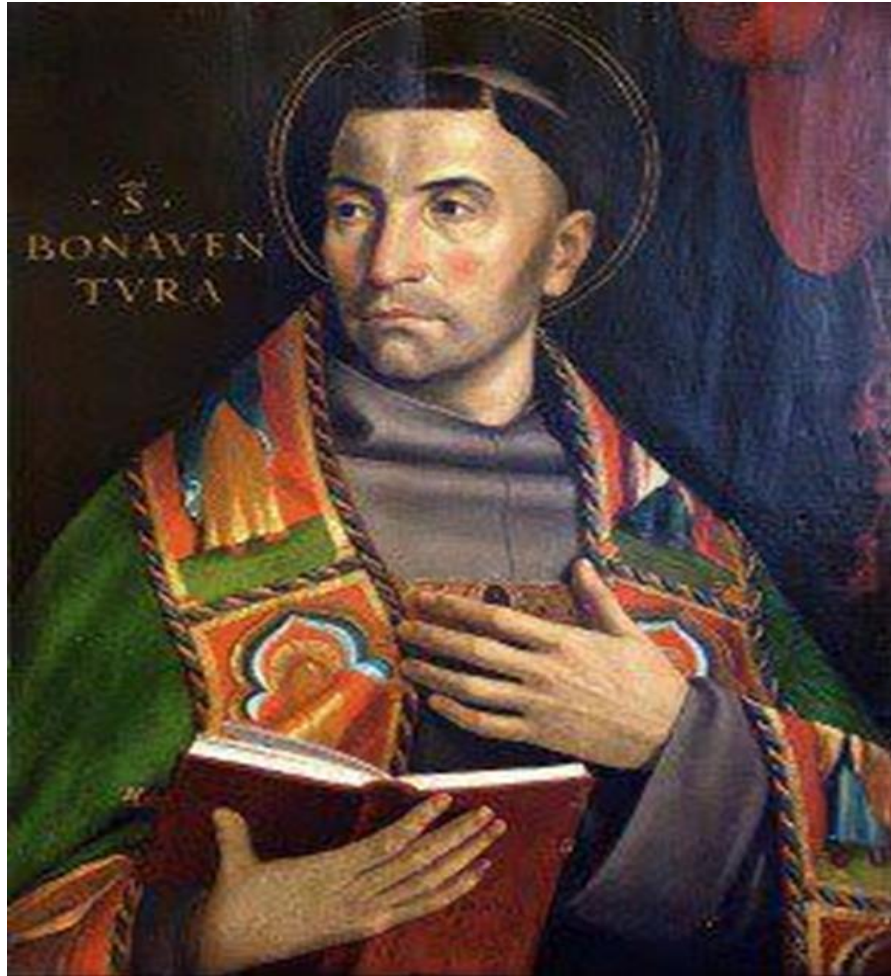

St Bonaventure ~ 15th July

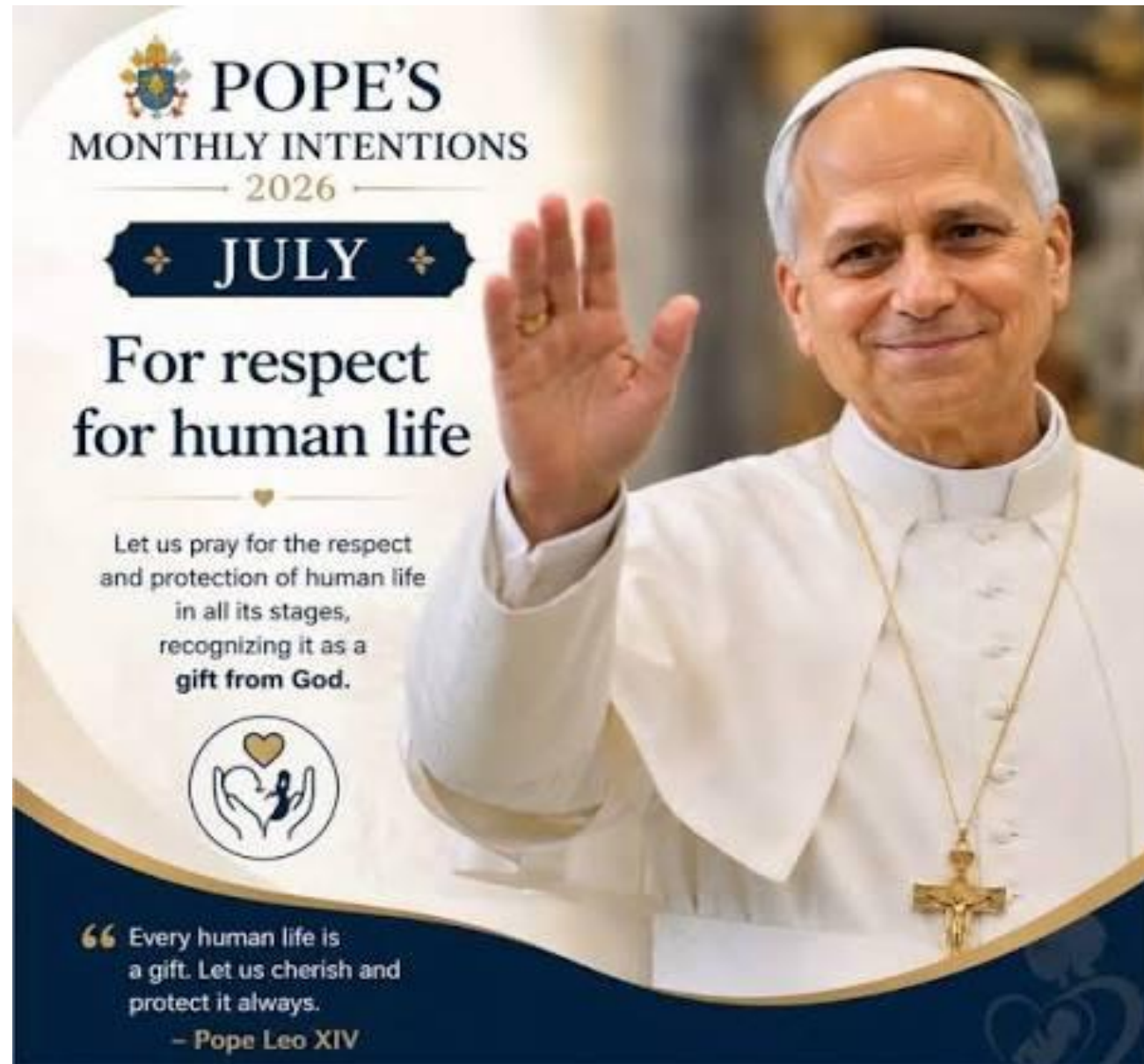
